# **Christian Youth In Action**

CYIA is a summer missionary training program designed to inspire, train and equip teens from local churches in Hawaii to share the Gospel with children all across the state through backyard Bible clubs called 5-Day Clubs.

#### What commitment do I need to make?

Students participating in CYIA commit to attending a two week training camp and then serving for at least two more weeks during the summer by helping lead 5-Day Clubs on Oahu and sometimes on neighbor islands. Students are also required to complete an application, provide references from two adults and be willing to put in the effort to be successful.



## Where is CYIA training going to be held?

This years two week training camp will take place at Molokai Baptist Church. (Yes, its on Molokai!) Accommodations will be bunkbeds for some and tents for others. MBC has a great facility, including a gym and six indoor showers!

#### How much does CYIA training cost?

The cost will be \$350 per student if registered and deposit paid by Monday, April 16th. This will include lodging, food, curriculum materials and airfare from Oahu on Makani Kai Airlines. If registered after April 16th, the price increases to \$450 per student. So register early! Students from ALL islands are invited to participate. Special discounts will be given to students participating from islands other than Oahu. Please contact Matt Walton (see below) for more details. Financial aid is available and will be given on a case by case basis. We will do everything we can to make CYIA affordable for every student interested.



### Are there any restrictions?

In order to participate, students must be 13 years old by June 1st, 2018.
