2018 Christian Youth In Action Requirements & Application Process

Thank you for considering participating in this year's Christian Youth In Action summer missionary training. This is going to be a banner year for CYIA since we'll be holding camp on Molokai for the first time ever. As you have hopefully already heard, CYIA is not your typical summer camp. As such, there is a rather in depth application process, which is clearly listed below. The purpose of this application process is to confirm each student's "fit" for our training program. We are seeking students who have a strong relationship with Christ and a deep desire to serve Him beyond normal church activities.

CYIA Application Requirements

- 1. Be age 13 by June 1st, 2018. (*Grace will be given on a case by case basis for "close" birthdates.*)
- 2. Be willing to attend the two week training camp June 2nd 16th on the island of Molokai.
- 3. Be willing to complete the necessary pre-camp preparations (see pre-camp form) before June 2nd.
- 4. Be willing to serve at least two additional weeks during the summer by teaching at 5-Day Clubs.
- 5. Be willing to ask your youth pastor or senior pastor to complete an online reference form on your behalf.
- 6. Be willing to ask at least one other adult (non-related) to also complete an online reference form on your behalf. (This can be a neighbor, family friend, coach, school teacher, etc.)
- 7. Be willing to complete the online application for CYIA and provide the following:
 - a. Your assurance of salvation. Describe how you became a Christian and how you know that you have faith in Christ.
 - b. Describe your personal devotional life. Honesty is appreciated here. If you do not have a daily quite time or read your Bible every day, don't make something up. Your application will not be denied for giving an honest answer.
 - c. Describe why you want to become a summer missionary through CYIA. Honesty again is appreciated. If you're parents are "forcing" or "bribing" you to attend, please tell us. Your application will not be denied for giving an honest answer.
- 8. Provide evidence of a "clean" TB test taken within two years of July 26th (the last day of our summer ministry).

As you can see, applying to participate in our summer missionary training is not easy. However, I can guarantee you that if you give it your best effort and are genuinely seeking to serve God through CYIA this summer <u>you</u> will be changed and God <u>will</u> use you!
